ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS



TEEN

- Is between 13-17 years of age as of 1/1/2023
- Is single, not married, has never been married is not pregnant & has never given birth.



MISS

- Is between 18-28 years of age as of 1/1/2023
- Is single, not married, has never been married is not pregnant & has never given birth.



MS.

- Is 29+ as of 1/1/2023
- Is single, divorced, with or without children



MRS.

- Is 18+ as of 1/1/2023
- Is legally married to her spouse
- If not a citizen or permanent resident is married to a U.S. citizen.

ALL DIVISIONS

- 1. Is a U.S. citizen, or has been granted permanent residency by the United States.
- 2. Is a resident, works, or goes to school in the state they are competing.
 - 3. Is a natural born female
 - 4. Has never appeared nude in photographs or film.

Dress for Success! Select an outfit suitable for a job interview. Dress, skirt suit, or pantsuit, whatever reflects your personal style!





OPENING NUMBER

You will need to wear a dress or romper of your choice in the color SILVER or GOLD. Rhinestones, pearls and other embellishments are allowed but no additional colors. Floor length dresses or Pants are not allowed for the opening number. It must be a cocktail style dress or shorts Rompers. You will need to provide and wear silver, clear or nude colored shoes.

FITNESS | SWIM

TEEN- Select any style athletic clothing & athletic shoes. MISS, MS., MRS.- Select any style swimsuit & heels. NO THONGS ALLOWED! Bottoms must provide adequate coverage!





EVENING GOWN

Better than beautiful! Select any style floor length formal dress that makes you feel like the Queen you are!

How well did the contestant's swimsuit flatter her figure? How well did the contestant convey confidence with body type & choice of swimsuit?

How well did the contestant model her gown in terms of technique and elegance?

How well did the contestant's gown flatter her figure? How well did the contestant convey confidence with body type and choice of gown?

 - Credit Card Authorization Form (Only used if in violation of contract or on delinquent accounts)
 - Photo release
 - Advertising release
- 4. Headshot, professional photo, NO sash and crowns allowed
- 5. Copy of birth certificate, naturalization, or permanent resident card
- 6. Copy of driver's license or identification card
- 7. Final divorce decree for any previously married MS contestants
- 8. Ad Page artwork/fees/forms (as soon as they are ready, but NO LATER than one month prior to the pageant)
- 9. MRS- Copy of marriage license.
- 10. Any other documents requested by director.
- 11. Judges Bio Form- added to dropbox 4 weeks prior to pageant

*Items 4-11 are due no later than one month prior to Pageant

BACKSTAGE REGULATIONS

No one is allowed in the backstage dressing area during the pageant other than the contestant. We will have staff backstage to help with wardrobe if necessary.



PAGEANT ETIQUETTE

None of these things will win or lose a pageant for you. However, once you have entered the pageant everyone is watching you, and it is important to make a good impression. These guidelines will help you create an impression of a responsible, confident, organized individual who can handle any job given to her.

- ❖ Meet every deadline, or call for an extension!
- Follow all rules! They are for your safety and security.
- ❖ Be neat and clean! No one should have to pick up after you.
- ❖ Be organized! It is your responsibility to know what's happening and be ready.
- ❖ Get acquainted! You should get to know the other contestants, the contestant coordinators, and our Team. Most importantly, be respectful to everyone!
- Be complimentary of all accommodations and meals! Sponsors and staff always do their best, please remember that.
- ❖ Be cheerful even if you are not "the winner." Only one person can win the crown, and you are a winner for representing your local title!
- ❖ Be a gracious winner! It happens once in a lifetime, and many others would like to be in your shoes!
